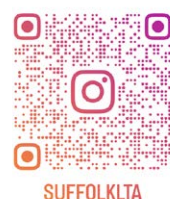

In Memoriam

During the last 12 months we have lost two people who would have been very much part of the Framlingham Tournament's history

Neil Songer (died 5th April 2024, aged 61)

When the Draws and Schedules of Play were all prepared manually and involved long nights in the referee's office, Neil was an assistant referee at Framlingham for several years before moving on to become a very popular and respected referee throughout Suffolk, Norfolk and Cambridgeshire. Sheelagh Watts described him as "Known to be firm but fair, he was considered the type of referee who was never phased by a difficult situation. More importantly Neil possessed the capacity, some would say 'gift', to make tennis fun for all involved. This was never more exemplified by his genuine interest in the progress of individual juniors that he encountered."

His contribution to Framlingham and Suffolk tennis was immense. Selflessly his involvement allowed others to play the game. His tennis friends, parents and juniors all owe a debt of gratitude to this kind and caring person.

JS (Pip) Wootton (died 12th June 2024, aged 97)

Pip Wootton was born in 1927 in Ipswich where his family had a hairdressing business. Tennis became a big love in his life. In the 1950's and 60's he had considerable success at Singles and Doubles in Suffolk. He played for Suffolk for many years and was Captain for a while. It was always his ambition to win the Framlingham Closed Singles and was still trying into his thirties. He had already won three Closed Doubles Titles with his friend Freddie Beer, but the Singles title eluded him.

In 1963 he suffered from a very bad back, was in hospital for 5 weeks and advised to abandon playing serious tennis again. However, Pip gradually resumed playing and improving so by 1967 he had won some more titles.

In 1968 at the age of 41 he approached the Framlingham tournament with optimism although he was an outside bet. In the first round he beat John Grimwade then Hugo Langton, Robert Montgomery and Larry Fulcher before meeting Roger Knights, a strong favourite, in the final. Pip won 6-3, 9-11, 6-3 in a match that lasted well over two and a half hours and had three different umpires starting with Peter Andreason and ending with Lord Belstead. Pip's quote about the match: "I had overcome a technically and physically superior opponent by resilience, stamina, temperament and, finally, the exercise of the grey cells." This sums him up. Pip had a difficult style to play against, he was a strong tactician and had a tough temperament.

Pip later moved to Harleston, Norfolk where he continued to play tennis and squash into his later years. He remained a much loved and valued Patron of Framlingham until the day he died. He left two daughters.

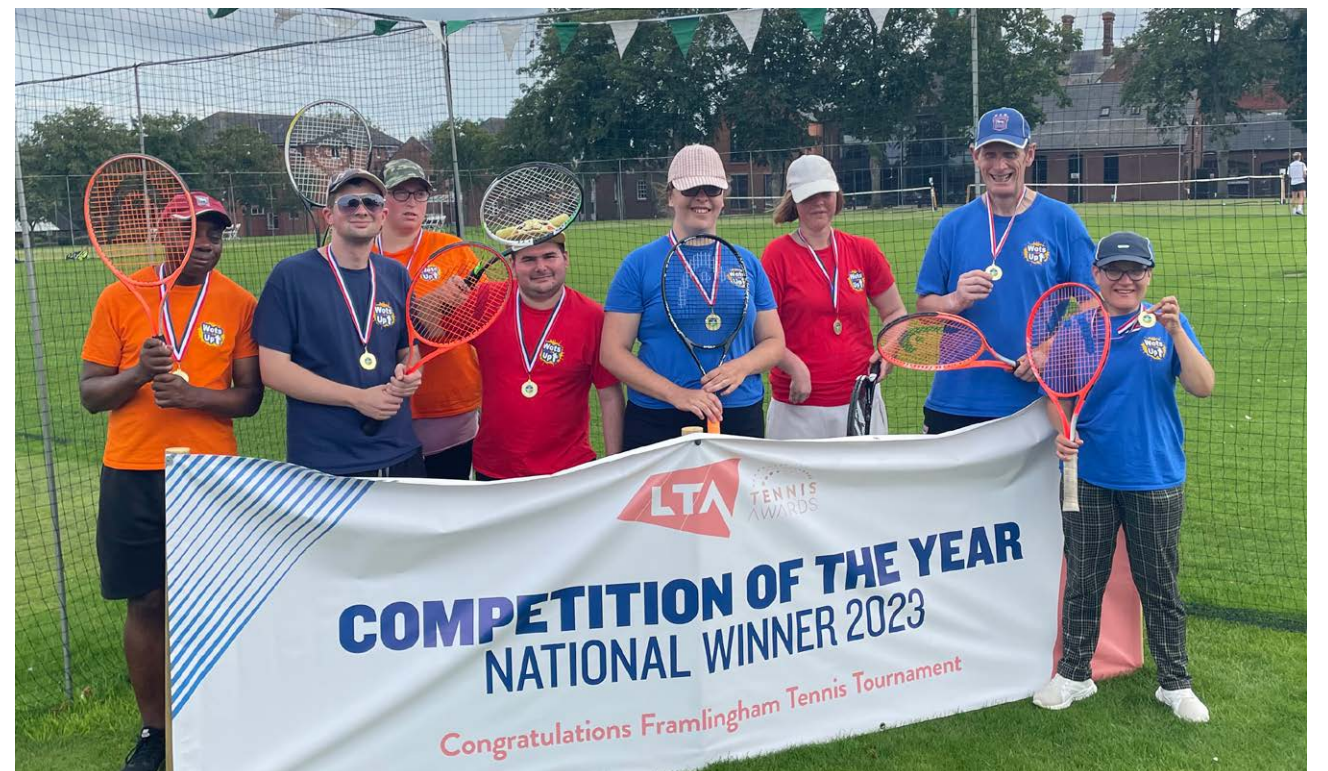

Framlingham Tennis Tournament A Yearlong Project

Ever wondered about the planning and preparation that goes into making Framlingham Tennis Tournament the success that it is? This is, after all, the 2023 LTA Tournament of the Year.

For Framlingham Tennis Tournament Chairman, Jeremy Scowsill, planning starts a whole ten months before the first ball is hit when he has to apply to the LTA to be a registered Grade 3 tournament. By achieving grade 3 status, Framlingham is not only able to attract grassroot players who enjoy playing for fun, but also players who are seeking to move up the performance rankings in British tennis. Jeremy Scowsill states, "Primarily we are a family tournament for all ages. However, maintaining Grade 3 LTA accreditation enables us to attract some of the up-and-coming stars of the future. In addition to inspiring our younger players it also provides an opportunity for our sponsors, patrons, and spectators to watch a very high standard of tennis."

The tournament can become a stepping-stone especially for juniors who are seeking to gain more ranking points to enable them to move up the competitive ladder in tennis. Indeed, this summer there has been no greater example of this than East Anglian based, Henry Patten, who was crowned Wimbledon champion in the Men's Doubles having won here at Framlingham as recently as 2019. It is a real achievement for Henry but also a huge inspiration for everyone competing in the Framlingham Open Tournament and Suffolk Closed Championships.

Having secured the week on the LTA calendar, preparations get into full swing.

As early as January, the Framlingham Tournament Team get in touch with Framlingham College. Without their constant help and support in the buildup as well as during the competition week, the tournament would not be possible. The ground staff have the tricky job of turning a cricket pitch into 13 grass tennis



courts and they always do a fantastic job. This summer has especially proven that British summer weather is very unpredictable so adaption to all elements is key.

Framlingham College's Director of External Relations, Melanie Lewis explains: "Framlingham College is honoured to host the prestigious Framlingham Tennis Tournament. We take real pride in the historic association the College has with the event and our commitment to providing top-class facilities and a memorable experience for all participants and spectators is unwavering. Months of meticulous planning from multiple departments across the College go into the event, from preparing our immaculate courts to coordinating catering provision and creating outstanding spectator spaces. Hosting this event aligns with our values of promoting sporting excellence and community spirit and we are delighted to see the tournament continue to thrive."

During the tournament week, the College plays a central role in hosting the event. The café team do an amazing job of making sure everyone is hydrated and fed and ready to play, and possibly even celebrate after a win! The College also make sure that all the sponsors and patrons enjoy their celebratory lunch. Looking after key sponsors and patrons is crucial as without their support and financial aid, the tournament would not go ahead. There are over 100 patrons and 55 sponsors. Every February, the tournament team get in touch with sponsors from the previous year to check they would like to renew their sponsorship. It's also at this time that the team actively try to recruit new sponsors.

On 16th January 2018, in our 125th year, Framlingham Tennis Tournament became a Registered Charity.

What have we done?

We became a Charitable Incorporated Organisation (CIO), a relatively new type of Charity structure which is designed specifically for organisations of our size.

You can look us up on the Charity Commission website and our Registered Charity number is **1176689**.

Our official purpose is “the promotion of community participation in healthy recreation in particular but not exclusively by the provision of facilities for tennis tournaments”. Basically that means we continue to run the second oldest tennis tournament in the country and encourage the improvement of amateur tennis skills for all players!

Why did we become a charity?

The Committee are a bunch of passionate tennis players who believed that in the 125th year we must celebrate the past and even more importantly secure the future of the tournament in these turbulent times!

To cut a very long story short, we consulted with many of the players, patrons, volunteers and advisory businesses who kindly sponsor the tournament and together we agreed that becoming a Charity would allow us to:

- Attract and retain more tournament entrants
- Raise a little more money every year to support the running of the tournament
- Encourage our special volunteers to get even more involved
- Create a Governance structure that was supportive of our aims

We are determined to keep this fabulous historic family tournament alive and vibrant!

Was there an impact on the Tournament?

Very little has changed apart from the fact that it is even easier to get involved!

We will still plan, manage and operate the second oldest annual tennis tournament in the UK, as sanctioned by The Lawn Tennis Association (LTA).

It will continue to open to all tennis players and is organised on a not-for-profit basis with all proceeds reinvested in the tournament.

Entrance to the grounds to watch the Framlingham tennis Tournament is free! It runs for 6 days from the first Monday of every August.

Naturally, we will continue to review our structure periodically to ensure it meets our goals and actively supports our future.

Terms & Conditions of Entry

Complaints

If you are unhappy with any matter in connection with the tournament, you may raise the matter verbally with the referee. If you are still not satisfied, a written complaint may be lodged with the LTA using the Contact Us Form at <https://www.lta.org.uk/about-us/contact-us/>. The LTA will determine what further action, if any, should be taken, including referring the matter to another party such as a club, County Association or Organising Committee and/or the LTA Disciplinary Officer (to be dealt with in accordance with the LTA's Disciplinary and Dispute Resolution Procedures). For the avoidance of doubt, the results of all matches connected to the complaint will stand in any event.

Official Shout Outs

If you have a positive experience with a Referee or Court Supervisor consider giving them a Shout Out.

Scheduling

Match times are fixed by the referee and are not negotiable. All applicants are considered available to play all times throughout the published dates and times of the tournament. Should you have any valid scheduling requests, please contact the tournament referee with as much notice as possible. It is each player's responsibility to find out when they are required to play. First match times will usually be sent to players by email. This information will also be published on the LTA Competition Portal as well. If you have not been informed when you are playing within 48 hours of the start of the tournament, please contact the tournament referee. If miss your match, you will lose your entry fee and be subject to no show penalties under the LTA Withdrawal Penalty system. During the tournament, you must not leave the club without checking if and when you are required to play next.

Liability

All players who enter this tournament use the venue and compete at their own risk. Neither the tournament, its officials nor the venue, its staff, management or committee will be responsible for death, personal injury, or loss of or damage to property whether occurring on the premises or otherwise, other than liability for negligence incurred under English law. If we make a mistake which prevents you from playing or continuing in the tournament, the maximum amount we shall be liable for is the value of your entry fee.

Ownership

With the exception of LTA Staged Competitions, ownership of the competition lies with the Tournament Organiser/ Organising Committee not the LTA. Any correspondence in relation to the tournament shall be directed to the named Tournament Organiser on this fact sheet.

Wild Cards

The organiser/organising committee reserves the right to issue wild cards, in accordance with LTA Competition Regulations.

Refund Policy

Standard Refund Policy

You will not be charged an entry fee for an event if

- we cancel the tournament
- we decide not to run an event
- your application to an event was unsuccessful
- you cancelled an application prior to the published cancellation deadline (subject to an admin fee)
- you were placed on a reserve list but were not called upon to play
- you were placed on a reserve list and invited to take part with less than 24 hours' notice and decided not to accept
- we are unable to accept your application for any other reason

We shall refund any entry fee paid for any event which is cancelled, curtailed or abandoned provided that

- you have not started a match in the event
- you have not withdrawn (after the cancellation deadline) prior to the decision to cancel, curtail or abandon the event

Refunds will not be made

- if a player withdraws after the published cancellation deadline for an event
- if a player fails to arrive at the tournament on time and misses their match as a consequence

- where consolation events/matches are cancelled, curtailed, abandoned or do not take place for any other reason
- in any other circumstances (except those detailed under "Liability").

The tournament is sanctioned by the Lawn Tennis Association ("the LTA") and will be run in strict accordance with the ITF Rules of Tennis, the Rules of the LTA and the LTA Competition Regulations, including the LTA Code of Conduct (as each may be amended from time to time). By submitting an application to this tournament you acknowledge and agree that you are subject to the Rules and Regulations of the LTA including the application of the LTA Competition Regulations (including the LTA Code of Conduct), the ITF Rules of Tennis and the Rules of the LTA (including the LTA's Disciplinary and Dispute Resolution Procedures, Tennis Anti-Doping Program and Regulations concerning Match Fixing, Financial Speculation and Betting). The tournament committee may alter or add to these rules in which case we will post written details on the tournament notice board and/or the tournament website. The referee shall however have general discretionary powers in interpreting any rule or regulation relating to the tournament and in situations not specifically covered by any applicable rules or regulations governing this tournament.

Safeguarding Information

1. This LTA Sanctioned Competition is being run at an LTA Registered Venue.
2. All LTA Registered Venues are required to meet certain safeguarding standards.
